The Volunteer Management System (VMS) for Virginia Master Naturalists

During this session, you will be walked through the various features of our online volunteer reporting system: the Volunteer Management System or VMN-VMS. Pete will cover several key features of the system: logging into the VMS system; reviewing the home page; updating your profile and changing your password; adding volunteer hours, advanced training hours, and miles; and viewing your hours, the events calendar, roster, documents, projects, newsletters, and photo albums.
