- 5. Describe your plan for completing 40 hours of volunteer service and 8 hours of CE within one year.
- 6. Find and list the names and email addresses for your chapter's advisor, president, training chair, volunteer service/projects chair, membership chair, and lead person for help with the Better Impact system.
